- 4 cups shredded sharp cheddar
- 2 cups flour
- 2 cups finely chopped nuts
- 1 tsp. cayenne pepper
- 2 tsp. salt

Thoroughly cream butter and cheese together; then add other ingredients. Mix well. Roll into long roll and refrigerate several hours. Slice into thin rounds. 
