Dunscroft's Yummy Pecan Buns

(Recipe from Dunscroft By The Sea Bed and Breakfast in Cape Cod)

- 2 loaves frozen bread dough
- 2 cups halved pecans
- 1 cup melted butter (not margarine)
- Brown sugar (enough to coat balls of dough)

Thaw bread dough. Cover the bottom of a 13 x 9" metal pan with pecan halves. Put brown sugar in a large bowl. Place in a row in front of you (from left to right) the dough, melted butter, brown sugar, and pan with pecans. Pinch off 1 1/2 - 2" balls of dough. Roll in butter, then brown sugar, and place over the pecans. Repeat until all the dough is used. Cover with a light dishcloth and let rise for 2 hours or overnight in a warm place. Bake in a preheated 350 degree oven for 20-25 minutes until nicely browned. Using an oblong shaped tray or serving plate, hold tightly over the buns and immediately invert. Serve warm with 2 forks for pulling apart. Makes 16 to 18 buns.

These are so yummy with fresh fruit and coffee or tea. Enjoy!

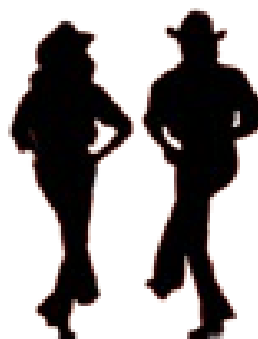

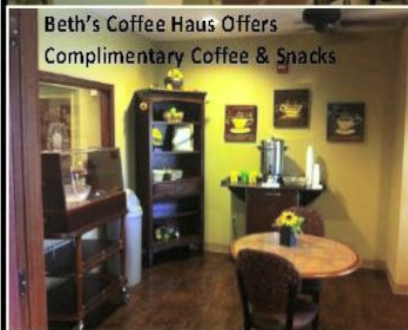

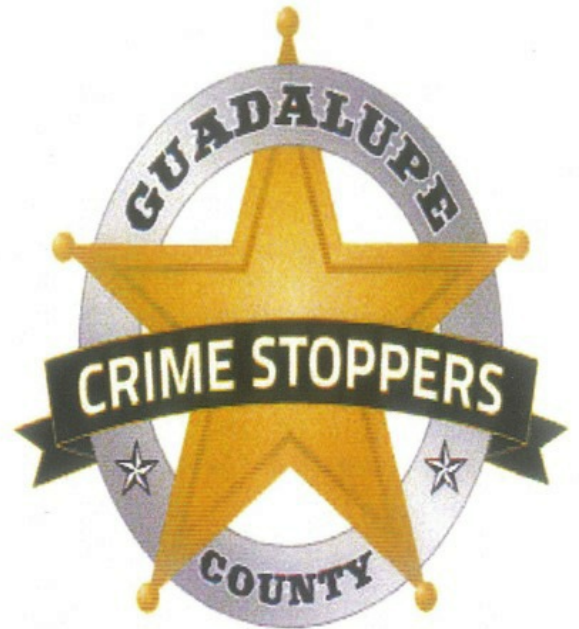
