
Potato People

Maple Oat Chewies

These are the most delicious cookies! Wonderful flavor and easy to make!

Makes 5 dozen cookies

1 cup sugar 1 3/4 cups All Purpose Flour

1 cup firmly packed brown sugar 2 tsps. baking powder

1 cup butter, softened 1 tsp. cinnamon

1 Tbsp. molasses (used mild molasses) 1/2 tsp salt

2 tsps. maple extract (used 1 Tbsp. Maple syrup) 2 cups rolled oats


2 eggs 2 cups Rice Crispies

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Grease cookie sheets. In a large bowl, beat sugar, brown sugar, and butter until light and fluffy. Add molasses, maple extract and eggs; blend well. Lightly spoon flour into measuring cup; level off. Add flour, baking powder, cinnamon, and salt; mix at medium speed until well-blended. Stir in oats and rice crispies. Drop by heaping teaspoonfuls 2 inches apart onto a greased cookie sheet.

Bake for 8 to 12 minutes or until light golden brown. Cool 2 minutes, then remove from cookie sheet. TIP: One cup of butterscotch chips can be added if desired.
