Cookies and Cream Cake

Cake:

 1 pkg. white cake mix
 1 1/4 cups water
 1/3 cup oil
 3 egg whites
 1 cup (approx. 8) Oreo cookies, coarsely crushed (Note: You may add additional crushed cookies if you desire.)

In a large mixing bowl combine cake mix, water, oil, and egg whites. Beat on low speed until moistened and then beat on high for 2 minutes. Gently fold in the crushed cookies. Pour into two greased and floured 8-inch round cake pans or one 13x9x2 inch greased pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes or until wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes and remove from pans to wire rack to cool completely

Frosting:

4-4 1/2 cups confectioners' sugar1/2 cup shortening1/4 cup milk1 tsp. vanilla extract

In a mixing bowl, beat the sugar, shortening, milk, and vanilla until smooth. Frost the cake. If desired, decorate the top with cookie halves and the sides with crushed cookies.
