Chippy Chocolate Cookies

2 pkgs. (18 ¼ oz. Each) chocolate cake mix 5 eggs 2/3 cup canola oil 1 package (10 - 12 oz.) vanilla or white chips 1 cup chopped pecans or walnuts

In a large bowl, beat the cake mix, eggs and oil. Stir in chips and nuts.

Drop by rounded tablespoons 2 inches apart onto the ungreased baking sheets. Bake at 350 degrees for 10 - 13 minutes or until set and tops are slightly cracked.

Cool for 2 minutes before removing to wire racks to cool.




