There will be a **BLOOD DRIVE** on Tuesday, **March 29th** at the Silver Center from **11:30 am to 6:00 pm**. The South Texas Blood and Tissue Center will be collecting all types of blood, but "O negative" donors are especially needed as they are the universal blood type. All donors will receive a t-shirt. Requirements include:

16 year old donors must weigh at least 120 pounds and have a signed parental consent form. You can visit the Donation Process page at southtexasblood.org to find the consent form. If the donor is 17+, he or she must weigh at least 110 pounds. All presenting donors must provide a photo ID, the last four digits of their Social Security number and birth date. Finally, all donors must be in good general health. BLOOD is the gift of life, so try to stop by. Orange Buttermilk Salad

- 1 can (20 oz.) unsweetened crushed pineapple, undrained
- 3 TBSP sugar
- 1 package (6 oz.) orange flavored gelatin
- 2 cups buttermilk
- 1 carton (8 oz.) frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 1 cup chopped nuts

In a saucepan, combine pineapple and sugar; bring to a boil, stirring occasionally. When mixture boils, immediately add gelatin and stir until dissolved. Remove from heat; cool slightly. Stir in buttermilk. Chill until partially set. Fold in whipped topping and nuts. If necessary, chill until mixture mounds slightly. Pour into a lightly oiled 8 1/2 cup mold. Chill overnight.

Yields: 12-16 servings



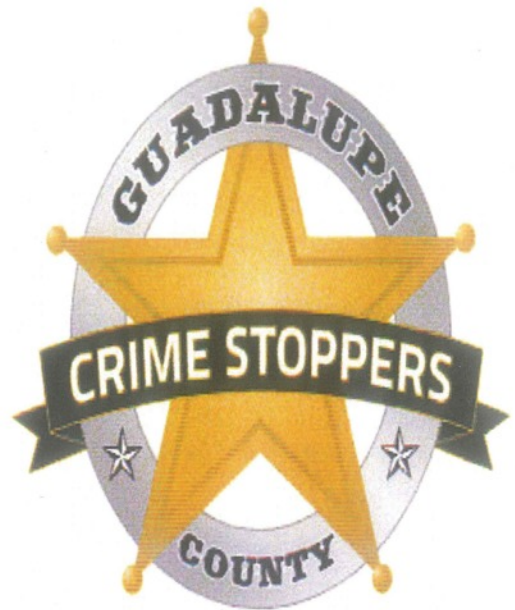
