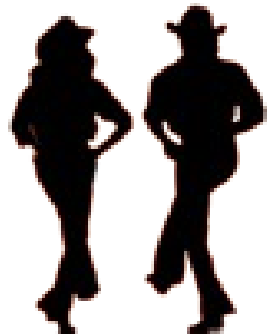

From classic country like Merle Haggard and Ronnie Milsap to Garth Brooks and Tim McGraw, Clifton will take the crowd on a memorable ride. 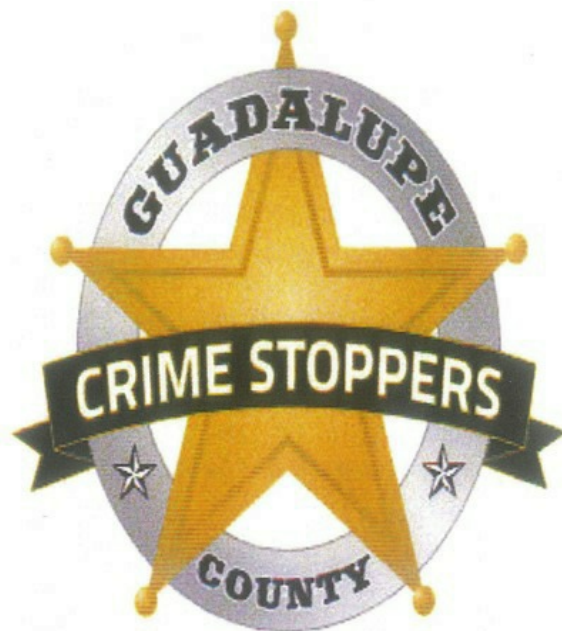

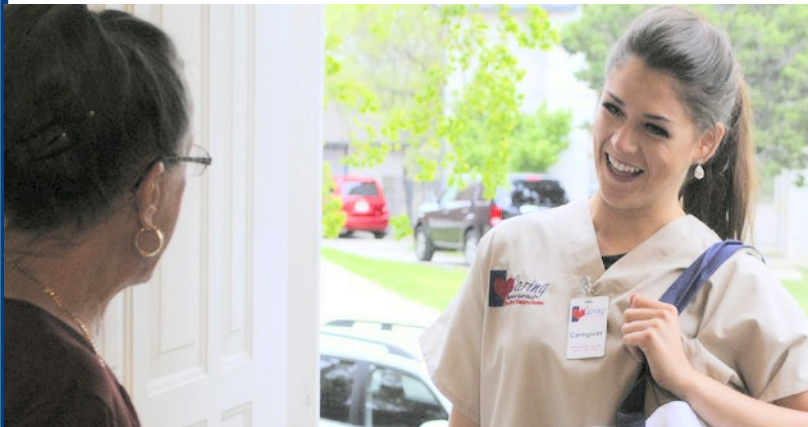

Peachy Chicken

Total Time to Prepare: 25 minutes

Yields: 4 servings

4 boneless skinless chicken breast halves
 1 Tbsp. canola oil
 1 Tbsp. butter
 1 can (15-¼ oz.) sliced peaches, undrained
 ½ cup packed brown sugar
 ½ cup orange juice
 1 envelope onion soup mix
 Cooked rice or egg noodles

In a large skillet, brown chicken in oil and butter over medium heat' remove and keep warm. Stir in the peaches with juice, brown sugar, orange juice and soup mix. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes. Reduce heat; return chicken to the pan. Simmer uncovered for 15-20 minutes or until a thermometer reads 170 degrees. Serve over rice or noodles.

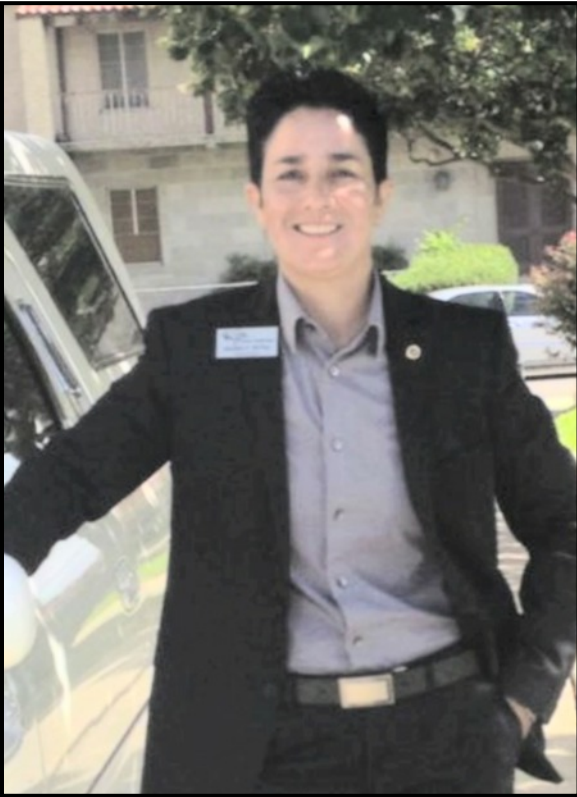
