4 boneless skinless chicken breast halves

1 Tbsp. canola oil

1 Tbsp. butter

1 can (15-1/4 oz.) sliced peaches, undrained

½ cup packed brown sugar

½ cup orange juice

1 envelope onion soup mix

Cooked rice or egg noodles


