Find relief at GRMC's new Resistant Hypertension Clinic

Do you or someone you love suffer from chronic hypertension or high blood pressure? Sometimes patients continue to take one, two or even three medications to try to get their blood pressure under control, causing unwanted symptoms and still frustrating best efforts to reverse the condition. 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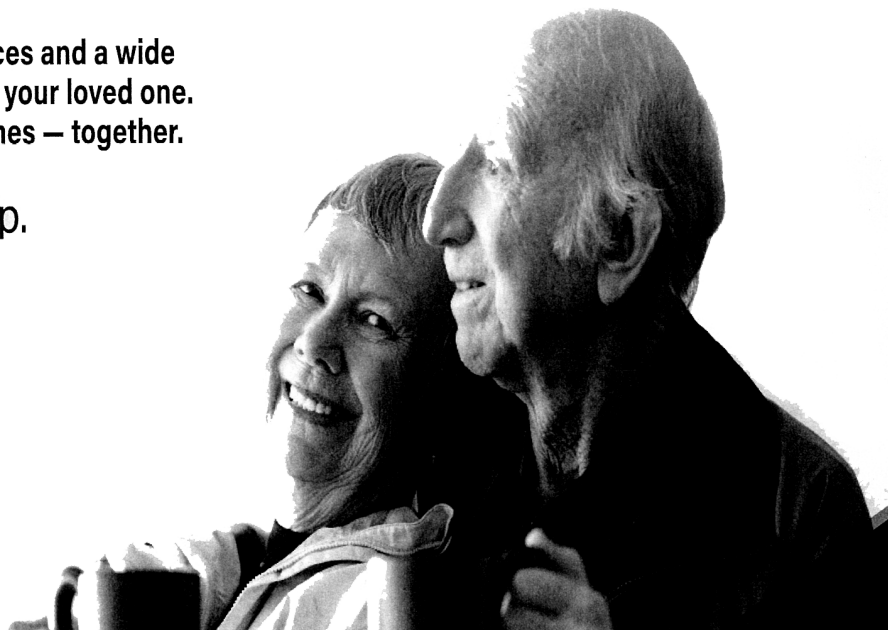

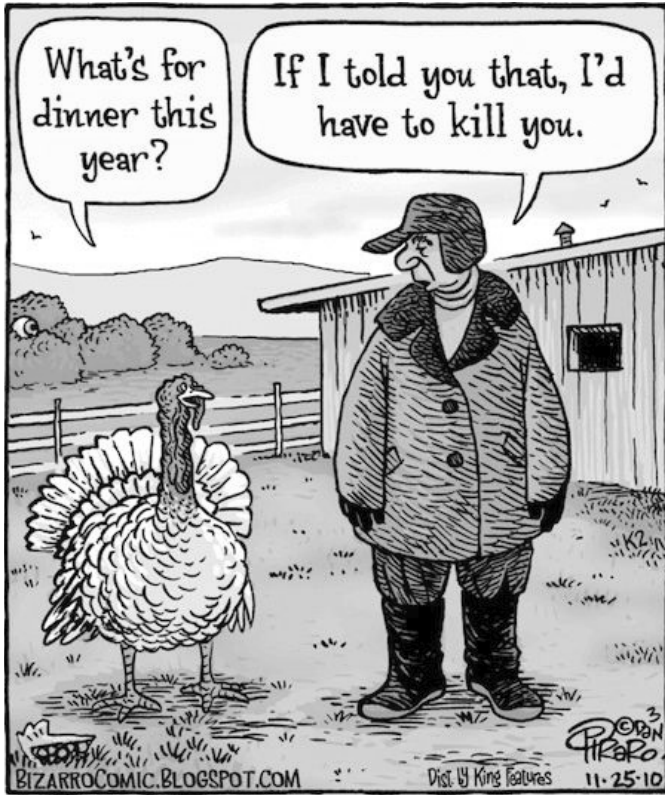
