Due to the huge void their leaving will cause, we will need to temporarily close the Thrift Store while we decide how to move forward. The Board has formed a committee that is looking at various options surrounding the Thrift Store. If you have any ideas, please put them in writing and mail or bring them to the center. Your ideas will be looked at and may be the best idea yet!

Another change has been the Friday night dance BYOB coverage. We have tried again and again to find liability coverage that would cover our facility for members who want to bring in their own liquor. Try as we might, no one we have contacted has been able to cover us. We now have 7 letters stating, due to lawsuits and high risks in this sort of policy, that they cannot offer any coverage if we allow BYOB at our dances. We still leave the option for coverage on the table. If anyone knows of an insurance company writing liability insurance policies that will allow BYOB coverage for us, and that company will bring forward a proposal to the Center to insure us, we will happily present it to the Board to see if we can afford it and then we might be able to bring back this option for our members! Until that time though, we will not be able to allow liquor to be brought in to our facility. I know that most of our members understand this is NOT a personal preference of any of your board members. This is simply a business decision because we CANNOT FIND AN INSURANCE COMPANY that wants to be placed in the high risk zone for unmonitored alcohol consumption. The Center could be wiped out by just one unfortunate automobile accident! We love all of our members dearly. We want you to all be happy and we want the Center to be here for all to enjoy for many, many years.

I hope your Fall is a happy and healthy one. I urge you all to discuss with your physicians your personal risk and see if a flu or pneumonia vaccination might be appropriate to help you make it through the season happy and healthy.

Please come in and enjoy YOUR Silver. We are always in need of volunteers for various committees. Would you like to help us with coordinating our volunteers? Would you like to work with our membership committee getting new members or mentoring new members so they get the most from their new membership? How about delivering meals to people unable to get out anymore? What a joy and benefit to those people in need of a smiling face and a warm heart! We have many opportunities.
