To date, we have had three companies respond and all of their underwriters have declined, again because of BYOB. One of our contacts stated this, "After talking with numerous underwriters, it seems that there has been a shift towards most companies not accepting BYOB type risks." We have not given up and are continuing to search. Please contact me if you know of any insurance companies that do still insure BYOB. I will gladly forward them our information. Thanks again for your patience and continued support during this time.
